

Community Data Worksheet

During the community assessment, you will be gathering data from numerous sources. This worksheet is intended to help you organize all the information you gather from surveys, interviews, Internet searches, and media analysis in one place. Although it's not a requirement to complete every blank, it's best to fill out as much as you can, as the information on this sheet can later help inform who the key stakeholders are, how to best approach a community, and how messages should be developed and communicated later in the process. This document is not meant to profile a community; rather it is intended as a "cheat sheet" for important data and information that is needed to inform communication activities. Following the charts below is a list of resources that can help you gather some of the data for the charts.
