**The challenge is to prevent new health risks.**




**Some brownfield properties are sold with insufficient assessment of the environmental conditions and related health impacts.**

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## **10 or more (p. 28\*)**

The Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (PRA): Offerors should be advised that any activities involving information collection (i.e., posing similar questions or requirements via surveys, questionnaires, telephonic requests, focus groups, etc.) from 10 or more non-Federal entities/persons, including States, are subject to PRA requirements and may require CDC to coordinate an Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Information Collection Request clearance prior to the start of information collection activities.

**OMB -- 60 days**

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# Target Area & Population (p. 7 & 14\*)

Applicants are **required** to outline the geographic target area(s) with one or more potential Brownfield/Land Reuse sites.

Target area could be any site, neighborhood, city, tribal land, or state if one or more potential Brownfield/Land Reuse Sites.

Due Date for Letter of Intent: **06/03/2016**

Due Date for Applications: **07/05/2016**, 11:59 p.m. U.S. Eastern Standard Time, at [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov).

SAM registration may take 10 or more business days. (p. 15)

Validation of filing may take as long as two business days. (p. 24-25)
